# Türkiye Becomes One of the Top 10 Steel-producing Countries in August

The world's crude steel production of the 70 countries reporting to the World Steel Association (worldsteel) was 145.3 million tons in August 2025, a 0.3% increase compared to August 2024.

## **Crude Steel Production by Region**

In Table 1, Asia and the Oceania produced 107.7 million tons in August 2025, up 0.4%, accounting for the largest share in the table. North America produced 9.1 million tons, up 1.6%, ranked second. The EU (27), ranked third, produced 8.8 million tons, down 2.8%.

Russia and other CIS plus Ukraine produced 6.7 million tons, down 4.9%. The Middle East produced 3.8 million tons, up 21.5%. Other European countries produced 3.7 million tons, up 2.1%. South America produced 3.6 million tons, down 5.0%. Africa produced 1.8 million tons, down 3.8% in August 2024.

The 70 countries included in Table 1 accounted for approximately 98% of total world crude steel production in 2024.

### **Top 10 Steel-producing Countries**

In Table 2, China, ranked first, produced 77.4 million tons in August 2025, down 0.7% on August 2024. India, ranked second, produced 14.1 million tons, up 13.2%. The United States, raked third, produced 7.2 million tons, up 3.2%.

Japan produced 6.6 million tons, down 3.4%. Russia is estimated to have produced 5.5 million tons, down 4.6%. South Korea produced 5.2 million tons, down 6.1%. Türkiye produced 3.4 million tons, up 7.9%, becoming one of the top 10 steel-producing countries in August. Germany produced 2.6 million tons, down 10.5%. Brazil produced 2.9 million tons, down 4.6%. Iran produced 1.6 million tons, up 17.9%.
